Diagnostic Medical Sonography at Integrity College of Health prepares students with skills and knowledge in producing two-dimensional ultrasonic recordings of internal organs using ultrasound equipment for use by physicians in diagnosing diseases and malfunctions of organs.

Employment of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers is projected to grow 19% from 2018 to 2028*, much faster than the average for all occupations.

As a Diagnostic Medical Sonographer (Ultrasound Technician), you will use special equipment to direct high frequency sound waves into a patient's body. The technical term for ultrasound is "sonography." Sonographers can specialize in areas like Obstetric and Gynecologic, Abdominal and Echocardiography.
