The **Medical Insurance Coding and Billing** at Integrity College of Health prepares students with the knowledge and skills for accurate maintenance of patient medical records.

Employment of Medical Insurance Coding and Billing Specialists is projected to grow 8% from 2019 to 2029*, faster than the average for all occupations.

The Medical Insurance Coding and Billing Specialist program provides theory and clinical training geared to prepare the student for an entry level position in various medical institutions. Instruction combines theory and practice to meet the competencies needed to be a medical biller and coder. Students learn to prepare various health claim forms using medical billing software. Students learn to accurately interpret medical records, including diagnoses and procedures of health care providers, as well as to document and code the information for submission to insurance companies. Graduates receive CPR and First Aid Certification from American Red Cross and Diploma in Medical Insurance Coding and Billing Specialist.
