Career Highlights & Opportunity

As a Veterinary Assistant, you will handle routine animal care and help scientists, veterinarians, and veterinary technologists and technicians with their daily tasks. Tasks include feeding, bathing and exercising animals, restraining animals during procedures, maintain and sterilize surgical instruments, care for animals after surgery and give medication and immunizations prescribed.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics*, overall employment of veterinary assistants is projected to grow 20% from 2022 to 2032, much faster than the average for all occupations.
