If you have been affected by the recent wildfires in Pasadena and Altadena, a variety of resources are available to assist you during this challenging time.

Here are some organizations and services offering support:

Emergency Shelters and Evacuation Centers:

- **Pasadena Convention Center**
300 E. Green St., Pasadena, CA. Parking is available at the structure across the street at 155 E. Green St. The Humane Society is on-site to accept pets for boarding.
- **Arcadia Community Center**
375 Campus Drive, Arcadia, CA. This center serves as a staging area where residents can charge devices, connect to Wi-Fi, and make shelter arrangements. They are unable to take any animals. For more information, call: 626.574.5130.

Animal Shelters:

- **Pasadena Humane Society**
361 S. Raymond Ave., Pasadena, CA. They have taken in over 300 pets displaced by the wildfires and are providing necessary medical treatments. They are also seeking donations and foster homes for animals.

Financial Assistance and Donations:

- **American Red Cross Los Angeles Region**

Food and Basic Necessities:

- **Los Angeles Regional Food Bank**

Health and Safety Advisories:

- **Pasadena Water and Power Advisory**
Residents in evacuated areas are advised not to use tap water for drinking and cooking due to potential contamination. Use only bottled water until further notice.

Federal Assistance:

- **Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)**
