Operating States

Integrity College of Health is approved to operate only within California. The institution has not determined whether its programs meet the educational requirements for licensure, certification, or credentialing in any state other than California.

State Disclosure for Programs leading to Licensure or Certification

Integrity College of Health has determined that the Vocational Nursing program meets the educational requirements for specific state licensing required for employment. The Bureau for Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians (BVNPT) sets specific minimum standards for licensure as a Vocational Nurse. The Vocational Nursing program at Integrity College of Health is approved by the BVNPT as meeting the minimum standards set for application for licensure. Upon successful completion of the Vocational Nursing program at Integrity College of Health, the graduate will be eligible to apply for the licensing examination given by the BVNPT. Nursing boards in each state establish the requirements for licensure for their state and requirements vary state by state. Students who intend to use their Integrity College of Health Vocational Nursing Diploma to secure licensure outside of the state of California will need to review the nursing licensing board in that state and contact them to verify eligibility.

Physical Location Determination

Integrity College of Health determines the student's physical location during the admissions process. Applicants share their address on the Application for Admission. Their address is verified through a government issued ID that is collected as part of the admissions process. Students located outside of California are not accepted into Integrity College of Health.

Students at Integrity College of Health can update their personal information, including address, by completing a Student Information Form (please see your campus Registrar). Please note, students must notify the institution if they plan to relocate out of state.

If an enrolled student moves out of California, Integrity College of Health provides direct notice to the student via email within 14 days after the day the change in determination is identified by Legacy Education. Relocating out of state may adversely impact a student's ability to complete their program. Students are encouraged to speak with ICH staff before relocating to determine options for continuing training or withdrawing prior to moving outside of California.
